

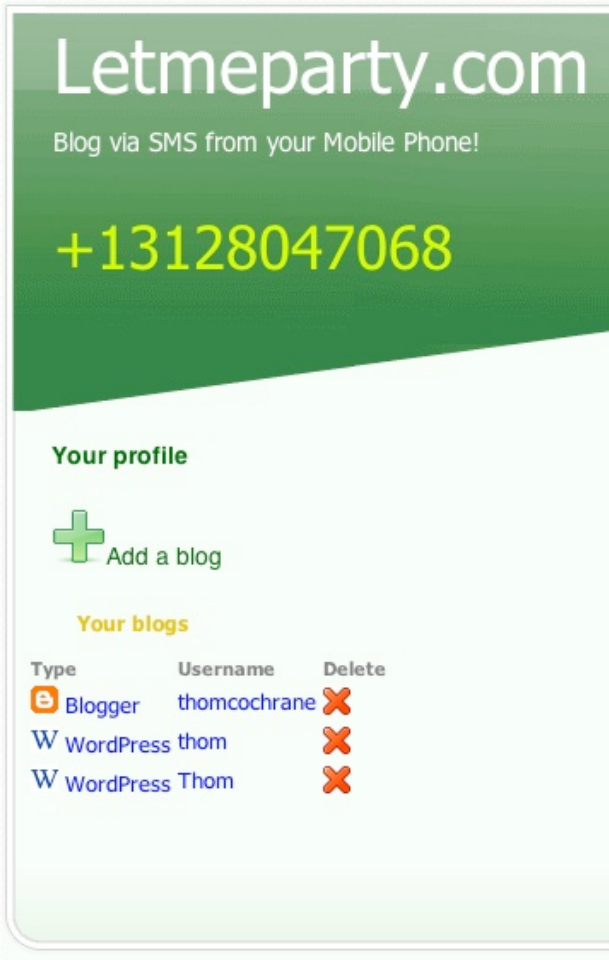
The simplest mobile blogging solution is to use text messaging to post to your blog.

The main limitation is the 160-character limit of text messages, so your SMS blog posts will always be short. Most mobile carriers provide an SMS blog service for their customers, however their blog software is usually not as configurable as the more popular mainstream blog hosts such as **WordPress.com**. To SMS post to a **WordPress.com** blog hosts requires an intermediary service. One such free service is <http://letmeparty.com>. This is simple to set-up, and works with the most popular blog hosts.

1. First use a PC with [Firefox](#) (letmeparty.com does not support Internet Explorer) to create a free registration at letmeparty.com



2. Register your mobile phone number (in international format: i.e. +6421xxxxxx for Vodafone NZ, leaving out the '0')
3. Enter your blog host type, address, username and password.

4. Finally send your SMS to +13128047068 and letmeparty.com forwards your SMS to your blog as a post.

Using Letmeparty.com you can Blog from any cellphone for the cost of a txt message only!
